Characteristics of Our Purchase Contract


- Part of the 2010 Settlement
- The contract defines the when and how of the sale
- Agreement is one sided
 - Grier family must sell to us
 - We MAY buy if all conditions are met
- What are those conditions?
 - FAHA has enough people sign association agreement to make the purchase
 - We accept the appraised price
- Price?
 - Determined by board of three appraisers


Airport Property Included in the 2010 Settlement

Must buy all airport parcels (runway, taxiway, office, fuel farm, tie downs and hangars)



King County assessed value increased from \$2.3 million in 2021 to \$3.0 million for 2022.


Purchase Timeline Illustration



2.5% of \$3.5 million is \$87,500

An appraisal taking 60 days could result in purchase taking up to 180 days to complete.
